#### SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

Thank you for participating in this show. The management of this show are extremely concerned that it is a fun and worthwhile event for all. Your consideration of the below mentioned, as well as the consideration of others in the show will help to make the show a rewarding experience for everyone.

#### EXHIBITOR HOURS

The exhibitor entrance will be open one hour prior to the show opening for cleaning and rearranging of displays, etc. **24 hour security will be provided.**

#### MOVE-IN

Thursday, April 26, 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.  
Friday, April 27, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

**Vehicles must be in the arena by 2:00 p.m. Friday** and all set up MUST be complete by 4 p.m., as there cannot be any set up or move in while the show is open.

#### SHOW TIMES

Friday, April 27, 6 PM - 10 PM  
Saturday, April 28, 10 AM - 10 PM  
Sunday, April 29, 11 AM - 5 PM

#### MOVE-OUT

Sunday, April 29, 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. All removal must be completed on time, or you may be responsible for towing, removal, and storage or clean up charges – unless otherwise agreed with show's management in writing. **No move out of vehicles or tearing down of displays will be permitted before the awards presentations have been completed.**

#### ADMISSION PASSES

With each confirmed and accepted entry, upon move-in, two weekend passes will be issued. The passes must be shown at the door to gain entry to the show.

#### AWARDS

The awards will be presented on Sunday at 4 p.m

#### AWARD CATEGORIES

Please see reverse for award categories. Please note that the categories may be modified as required.

**PLEASE NOTE: Locked cars will NOT be judged.**  
**Entries to be judged must have hood, doors and trunk open from setup to tear down. Judges will not open cars.**

#### SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. No alarms of any kind are to be set while the vehicle is in the building
2. For promotional purposes, the show management has the right to use any submitted photographs of the displayed vehicles.
3. No commercial advertising, or distribution of handouts, business cards or flyers, etc. will be permitted with any non-commercial display, unless permission is granted in writing by the show management. A vehicle specification display sign is permitted.
4. Neither the show management, the sponsors and their staff, nor any officer or staff member, director or shareholder connected to the show, as well as the owners, staff and managers of the building where

5. the show is produced shall be responsible or liable for any loss or damage to any part of the exhibitors display or vehicle.
6. Once the exhibitor has placed the vehicle and its display, they shall not be able to remove or conceal the vehicle until the declaration by the show management that move-out has officially begun.
7. The vehicle must be removed from the building by the conclusion of the designated move-out time or the exhibitor will be responsible for any towing and/or storage fees.
8. All displays must be free standing and composed of fireproof materials. All batteries must be disconnected and gas caps either locked or taped. **Drip protection MUST be used under vehicle engine, transmission and rear end.**
9. The owner of the displayed vehicle must have his/her own insurance on the vehicle, the display and the accessories. The insurance must include public liability and the required permits for driving in and out of the show building.
10. No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the premises.
11. Chairs will not be permitted in the display area therefore sitting by the car display is forbidden.
12. The show management has the right to have an entrant or exhibitor, or a member of his/her party removed from the show and building for misconduct or mischievous behavior.
13. Entrants should provide their own stanchions and rope.
14. Careless or reckless driving **will not be tolerated.** This includes during setup and tear down.
15. Electrical connections are not available.

**Tow money will be paid to out of town entries (from 100 km or over) at thirty (30¢) cents per km one way (Max 1,000km).**

#### HOW TO ENTER YOUR VEHICLE INTO THE SHOW

Please complete the application form and send it along with a good quality photograph which will be returned to you. Please have your \$30.00 per vehicle entry fee accompany the entry application, along with any additional fees. **One application form for each vehicle please.**

**Show management reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry at its own discretion. You will be notified either way about your acceptance.**

Sending in an application will be taken as the understanding that these regulations and all conditions are agreed to by the entrant or exhibitor.
